The violence in Myanmar is still present. However, through God's grace, our five partners in this country have remained safe. During a recent video call with our Agape Home, the director stated that shots can be heard throughout the night as they do not venture outside past 7pm. The internet is restricted to certain parts of the day and electrical outages are common.



Our partner "T" says, "Since 2021, Myanmar has faced immense challenges in every aspect of life. People have struggled to find happiness or hope in their daily circumstances. However, as Christians who trust in God, we have embraced this time as an opportunity to further spread the gospel. Wherever we are, that is our mission field."

Our partner Junia operates the New Hope home and states that they held a salvation crusade program. During this, children learned to stand firm in their faith amidst the country's crisis while allowing others to reconsider their lives and how much they need the Savior.

Thankfully, the children have been able to attend Christian school and just finished their final exams. Most plan to attend summer English classes. They are also enjoying time with their new equipment purchased with the Ready, Set, Go! funds that were given last year with your help.

Grace Home: Grace and Kim continue to experience health issues.

GEM Home: The Elim farm continues to produce fruit and is a refuge for the children.

Building a School in Liberia: Education for a Brighter Future

At BCH, we believe that **education is one of the most powerful tools to break the cycle of poverty.** That is why we are committed to building a **new school in Liberia**, providing children with the opportunity to learn, grow, and dream of a brighter future.

In the Village of Gbonota, many children face **significant barriers to education** that stem from extreme poverty- hunger, illness, sickness, and the lack of an accessible school. The local church plant has stepped up to form a private school held in just their one-room church building and in a smaller building made of mud. The children, parents, and teachers are dedicated to their education and recently, enrollment has greatly increased!





The residents of Gbonota know

exactly what this school means for their children—hope, opportunity, and a brighter future! Parents are overjoyed knowing their kids will have access to education and technology that was once out of reach. They have even started "rolling up their sleeves" and began transporting sand to the construction site by buckets and wheel burrows!

This new building will not only provide classrooms for children, but it will also serve as a center of hope, offering vocational training for teens and adults in the evenings, equipping the entire community with valuable skills and opportunities!
