
A SCHOOL RISES IN GBONOTA -

CHILDREN IN MYANMAR MEET NOAH


A SUMMER ROOTED IN GOD'S WORD-News from Myanmar

Even while school is out, the children in Myanmar are growing in knowledge—and more importantly, in faith. We recently received a joyful letter from Brother Hao and Sister Grace, who are faithfully shepherding the children at what we call The Grace Home. Thanks to your prayers and support, their summer break has been filled with spiritual growth and biblical teaching.

"Greetings to you all in the sweet name of Jesus Christ from Myanmar. By the grace of God and through your prayers, we have a very beautiful privilege to spend our summer school vacation in a special way.

We have regular daily Bible reading and study. We have used the King James Version, which we purchased in April 2025. It is a brand-new Holy Bible. We also read the Burmese Bible—A.D. Judson's faithful translation.

Hao hosted vacation Bible classes during this summer vacation. We taught on the "Dispensations," the Rapture, and the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. We also studied the doctrines of sin and salvation.

We had a football match. All the boys played football games joyfully and several times. Both the boys and girls enjoyed the ping pong and badminton nets games. Besides those things, the boys play a Burmese traditional sport called Chinlone. In English they call it Cane-ball.
